Dr. Cione graduated from Baylor University. He attended U.T. Southwestern Medical School in Dallas where he graduated with the Hudson-Penn award as outstanding student in general surgery. He completed his general surgery residency at Parkland Memorial Hospital in Dallas. He is board certified in general surgery and is a fellow of the American College of Surgeons, and a member of the Society of American Gastrointestinal and Endoscopic Surgeons.

Dr. Cione has served as chairman of surgery at Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital in Plano as well as the former medical staff president and is currently the Medical Director of MIS. He is trained in robotic surgery, single site robotic surgery and advanced techniques in minimally invasive surgery. Dr. Cione is a member of the Trauma Team of surgeons at Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital in Plano.

Dr. Cione has been in private practice for 20 years in the North Texas area. At the present time, Dr. Cione trains on laparoscopic and robotic assisted ventral and inguinal hernia repair using Ventralight ST with Echo PS and 3DMax. To date he has performed over 3,000 laparoscopic inguinal, over 1,000 lap ventral and over 1600 robotic assisted hernia repairs. He also lectures regionally on both laparoscopic and robotic inguinal and ventral hernia repair.
