A graduate of Western University of Health Sciences in southern California, Dr. Prebil completed his surgical internship and residency at Maricopa Medical Center in Phoenix, Arizona, where he received the Harry Hale, M.D. Award as surgical resident of the year. One of the few general surgeons in Arizona to perform single site robotic surgery, he is one of the most experienced robotic general surgeons in the United States and has performed over 1,000 cases.

Dr. Prebil believes that robotic surgery changes the scope of surgery for the patient and the practitioner. "It allows surgery that was once limited to an open procedure to be done minimally invasively, with better precision, less pain and a faster patient recovery."

An associate Professor and Surgical Preceptor of Midwestern University, Dr. Prebil also serves as a consultant for Intuitive Surgical and runs one of the few da Vinci Robotic General Surgery Epicenters, where they instruct surgeons from around the world on new and innovative robotic techniques. He also serves as a consultant and instructor for Davol Inc. on complex hernia surgery.

Dr. Prebil is an attending Faculty Member for Robotic and Minimally Invasive Surgery at Maricopa Integrated Health System, Phoenix.
